**Slam Dunk Sermon Series**  
**Part 4 – Restoration**  
**Scripture: Revelation 21:1-4**

As a basketball shot, slam dunks are simple and straightforward, and when approached correctly a slam dunk is a win you can count on. During the *Slam Dunk* sermon series we are exploring slam dunk themes from the Bible--truths you can count on. In Part 4 we think about a certainty of God's character, namely that He is interested in restoration. It's not just that the Creator makes beautiful things (though he definitely has and does), but God's track record includes a desire to take broken things and make them whole again. This restoration includes both the physical and spiritual aspects of His creation, and the proof of God's commitment to renewal is made clear in the life, death and resurrection of His son.
