Legacy

Hezekiah – Courage and Bold Leadership II Kings 18:1-6

Leadership is more than "being in charge." It is privilege and it is responsibility. Leadership at times requires tough calls. It calls for courage and humility. In the Older Testament of the Bible we meet a young king who exercised extraordinary courage during a time of moral and spiritual malaise in Judah. One of the steps he took to challenge the malaise was to shatter a symbol that the people had considered sacred for 700 years. Why would he do that? That symbol had actually diverted people from the worship of God. If we can see that an idol is anything that usurps God's rightful place in our lives, we will see how Hezekiah's story has extraordinary relevance for us. You see, good things become detrimental things if we ever allow these "good things" in subtle ways to usurp the place of God.
